Peck Cho is a Distinguished Professor at the Center for Teaching and Learning, Dongguk University in Korea. He gave invited lectures to professors at 182 universities and currently offers the most popular on-line course for teachers in Korea. During his 20 year tenure as a professor in Mechanical Engineering at Michigan Technological University, Cho served as the Director of Innovation Center, the Director of Learning Center, and the Director of Student Success Center. A member of National Academy of Engineering of Korea, Cho has received numerous awards, such as Research Initiation Award from NSF, Distinguished Faculty Award by the State of Michigan, and Outstanding Teaching Award from American Society of Engineering Education. Cho is on the Policy Advisory Committee of the Ministry of Education and co-chairs the National Committee on Student Violence with the Prime Minister of Korea. Cho served as the Board Chairman of the Dream Tree Village for orphans, the Director of the National Center for Students at Risk, and the Director of the Center for Young and Gifted Entrepreneurs. Cho has authored many books and produced many TV documentaries on education.
